PAPUA- Ainod Village in Aifat District is now glowing with newfound brightness thanks to an impactful initiative by the 501 Task Forces of the Para Raider Infantry Battalion 501/Bajra Yudha Kostrad under the Indonesian Armed Forces Operational Command HABEMA.
